RM 10214.120 Understanding the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Initial Verification (IV) Matching Criteria

Depending on the document submitted, the response to a Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) initial verification (IV) request propagates the following:

- name,
- class of admission (COA) code,
- country,
- date of birth,
- date of entry,
- date admitted to,
- expiration date, and
- IV response message.

The Social Security Number Application Process (SSNAP) automatically compares the IV response with the information entered from the immigration document(s) to make a verified or not verified decision.

A. Matching criteria

The following table specifies which fields require a match and refers you to the appropriate reference when a discrepancy exists between the immigration document presented and the IV response:

B. IV response does not match

If there is a discrepancy between any of the information on the IV response and the immigration document submitted, it does not necessarily imply that the applicant is not authorized to be in the United States (U.S.). It may be the result of a typographical error or indicate the need for additional or corrected documentation.

Compare SSNAP entries to the immigration document to ensure there are no typos. If necessary, correct any of the data you entered and submit a new IV request. If all the data you entered is correct, request an additional verification (AV) following instructions in section RM 10214.150.


1. Name discrepancy


IMPORTANT: SSNAP does not consider the middle name shown on the immigration document and the middle initial shown on the IV response a discrepancy requiring an AV, since the Social Security Administration (SSA) does not consider the middle name part of a person's legal name. For SSA's definition of the legal name, see RM 10212.001.



2. COA Code discrepancy

SSNAP automatically verifies the “COA Code” on the immigration document when required. If the COA on the IV response does not agree with the COA shown on the non-immigrant evidence (commonly the I-94), request an AV following [RM 10214.150](#).

4. **Date of Birth discrepancy** SSNAP requires an exact match on the “Date of Birth” field. If the date of birth on the IV response does not agree with the date of birth on the immigration document presented, request an AV following [RM 10214.150](#).

NOTE: Some applicants may show the date of birth on the application in DDMMYYYY format because that is the way their country, or culture, records dates. Occasionally, the month and day characters may be transposed in the DHS electronic record, or are shown in the DHS electronic record, in DDMMYYYY format. If this appears to be the situation, request an AV in accordance with [RM 10214.150](#). There is no tolerance for these situations.
