RM 10214.125 Interpreting Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Initial Verification (IV) Responses

Interpreting IV responses

The Social Security Number Application Process (SSNAP) automatically compares the initial verification (IV) response with the SSNAP alien data entered from the immigration document to make a verified or not verified decision.

IV response verifies the immigration document

Continue processing the SSN application when

- required fields on the IV response match the information on the immigration document submitted, and
- IV response message agrees with the lawful alien status indicated on the immigration document

submitted.

IV response does not verify the immigration document

SSNAP automatically places the application in “Suspect” status when the:
