Interpreting Third Level Responses

The Social Security Number Application Process (SSNAP) automatically compares the Third Level response with the SSNAP alien data entered from the immigration document to make a verified or not verified decision. The Third Level response consists of two parts; a major response and a minor response. The minor response will allow SSA to process responses previously requiring SSA to use a paper G-845 form.

Third level response verifies the immigration document

When the Third Level response verifies the information on the immigration document,

- continue processing the SSN application
- base the decision on the Third Level response as well as other evidence the applicant submitted.

The Third Level response takes precedence over the prior determination of the person's alien status.

IMPORTANT:

DO NOT resubmit another initial verification (IV) request to see if the IV response now agrees with the immigration document.

DHS status verifiers **DO NOT** correct the online SAVE data or provide guidance to SSA concerning what to tell the applicant to do to correct the electronic DHS record.

Third Level Response does not verify the immigration document

Response does not match immigration document submitted

When the immigration document submitted

- does not match the Third Level Response (e.g., the applicant submitted an I-94 with COA code H1B and
- the Third Level response indicates "Lawful Permanent Resident" instead of "Non-immigrant"),

take these steps:

- Do not process the application and see;
- See, Following Up on Overdue or Questionable Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Responses [RM 10214.205](#)

Response is "Continue to Process"

When the Third Level response is "Continue to Process" ("USCIS is searching indices for further information"), do not take any action to process the SSN application until you receive the final DHS response. This is an interim reply indicating DHS needs more time to research the files.

Response indicates applicant should contact DHS

When the Third Level response

1. does not verify the information on the immigration document submitted, and
2. indicates SSA should refer the applicant to DHS, take these steps:
 - a. Do not process the application;
 - b. Provide written notice; use Form SSA-L676 (Refusal to Process SSN Application) to the applicant explaining
 - that we cannot process the application because we cannot verify the document, and
 - that they need to contact DHS to resolve with that agency why they could not verify their lawful alien status for SSA;
 - c. Provide "Information for Applicants: Verification of Immigration Status and How to Correct Your Records with USCIS" the [DHS Factsheet](#); and
 - d. Delete the SSN application.

- When the Third Level response indicates the document is expired, follow [RM 10211.135B.1](#).
- If DHS granted temporary protected status (TPS) and automatically extended the EAD, see [RM 10211.420E](#).

Response indicates document is altered or counterfeit:

- Do not process the SSN application when the Third Level response indicates the document is altered or counterfeit.
- Refer the case to the Office of Inspector General Field Division following [RM 10205.320](#).
